Requirements for Entering:

1. Exhibitors must read and comply with all **Fair Rules and Regulations**, located on page 2, for participation in the Woodstock Fair.
2. In any lot, an exhibitor may place only one entry, with the exception of lots 36, 46 and 72 which are unlimited.
3. A collection consists of not fewer than 5 and not more than 10 stems, unless otherwise stated.
4. All flowers must be grown by exhibitor; "Amateurs only". Nothing grown in a commercial garden is permitted.
5. Specimens entered in competition must be disease free and without insect damage.
6. Glass containers must be used to hold specimens to prevent tipping.
7. Artificial or silk flowers may not be used in any of the classes. No exceptions.
8. To keep the displays looking fresh, Superintendents, at their discretion, may dispose of some blossoms.
9. Judging will be by the Danish System, except where otherwise stated.
